DSOD REOPENING PRECAUTIONS, RESTRICTIONS, AND GUIDELINES

- **EMPLOYEE TRAINING** - All DSOD Employees will be trained on appropriate cleaning and disinfection, hand hygiene, and respiratory etiquette.
- **EMPLOYEE PRECAUTIONS** - All DSOD Employees will be required to wear a mask at all times. All DSOD Employees will wash or sanitize their hands upon entering the studio, in between interactions with dancers and immediately after using the restroom. All DSOD Employees will have their temperature checked daily. Any sick employees will be sent home immediately.
- **CLOSED LOBBY** - No Parents or Guests will be allowed to wait in the waiting rooms or lobby. No Parents or Guests will be allowed to use our restrooms. This will help us reduce exposure to all of our adults.
- **CLASS TIMES** - Some of the class times will need to be adjusted due to capacity restrictions. Unless we have contacted you directly regarding a time change, your class will take place at the studio at your usual time.
- **DROP OFF** - In order to keep the lobbies clear and to maintain restricted capacity, your Teacher will come out to the front of the studio and gather the dancers to take them to the room. **PLEASE BE ON TIME!** If you happen to miss your teacher, please call the office at the phone numbers below and a DSOD Staff Member will come out to get your child.

- **HAND SANITIZER** - All Dancers and Teachers will use hand sanitizer at the beginning and end of each class. Any Dancer or Teacher that uses the restroom **MUST** wash their hands before returning to class.
- **ENDING 5 MINUTES EARLY** - Classes will finish 5 minutes early to allow for transition time and for DSOD staff to have time to re-disinfect the rooms.
- **DANCER PICKUP** - Dancers will be walked outside by a DSOD Teacher/Staff Member to meet their parents in front of the studio. No parents will be allowed in the lobby due to capacity restrictions.
- **SANITATION** - A bleach and disinfectant commercial grade solution will be used to clean all mats, equipment, bathrooms, doorknobs, bathrooms, and other hard surfaces throughout the dance day.

We politely request that your child not attend classes at the studio if any of the following apply:

- Your child has an underlying pre-condition
- You, the parent, or your spouse or have an underlying pre-condition
- Your dancer lives with or is in very close contact with grandparents
- Your child, you or anyone in your household is experiencing or has experienced the following symptoms within the last 14 days:
 - Fever
 - Cough
 - Shortness of Breath
 - Difficulty Breathing
 - Chills
 - Muscle Pain
 - Headache
 - Sore Throat
 - New Loss of Taste or Smell
